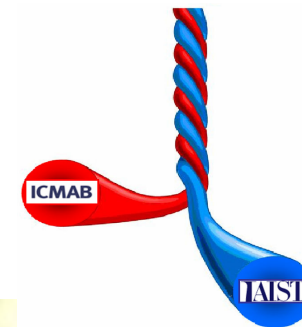


# Japan-Spain Symposium on Nanostructured Organic Photovoltaics

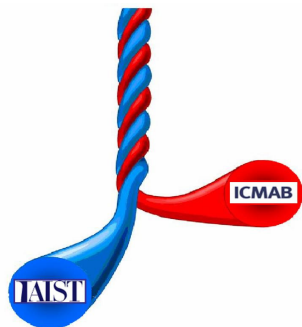

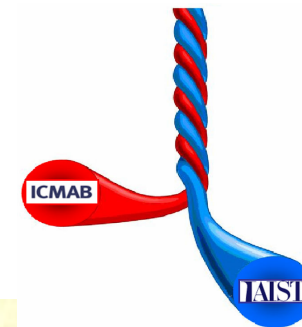

## Ferrocarrils de la Generalitat de Catalunya (FGC)

Line S2 : Barcelona-Sabadell, station: Universitat Autònoma.

Line S55: Barcelona-Universitat Autònoma

In Barcelona, these trains stop at Catalunya, Provença, Gràcia, Muntaner and Sarrià. The journey time to Barcelona is 30 minutes, and trains depart approximately every 10 minutes.

## RENFE (Spanish National Railway Network)

Line C7 - Cerdanyola Universitat station. From Barcelona you can take the train from Sants, Plaça Catalunya, Arc del Triomf and Sant Andreu Arenal. The journey takes around 30 minutes from the centre of Barcelona, with trains leaving every 30 minutes.
